Rough Area Update: We expect this week (barring any further rain) to finally be able to get caught up with mowing and trimming.

Invasive weeds (dandelions, clover, ect): Dandelions have become more prevalent, with our hindered ability to either cut or treat these weeds properly. However, with recent drying conditions the higher priority areas (Tee Boxes and Clubhouse Exterior) have been addressed. Both cutting and treatment of all other areas have resumed to better eradicate this challenge.
