

2022 Winnetka Cup Summary

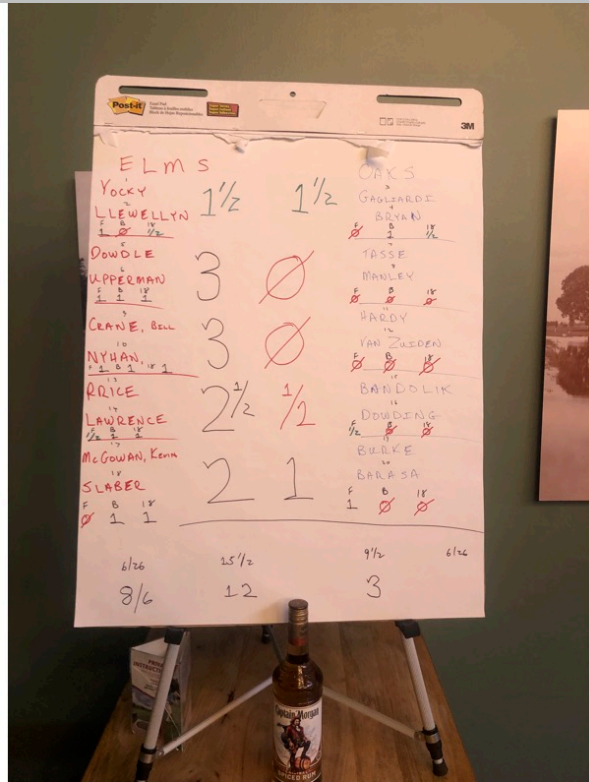
Stuart Cutler took over as captain of the Elms, and added some color to the competition .
